No. PS/763/M.-In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 and section 23-C of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, (Central Act 67 of 1957), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to issue standardized Registration Application form, Registration Certificate and stock register for Ready Mix Concrete Batching Mix Plants under the clause 26 and 29 of the "Punjab Crusher Policy 2022".

- i. **Ready Mix Concrete Batching Plant Registration Application Form:** All the readymix concrete batching plants shall be registered with the Department of Mines and Geology, Punjab. The Application form for registration shall be submitted to the department through online mode on the web portal. Registration will be one time only and no fees is payable for the registration. The standardized format for registration is annexed at Annexure 'A'.
- ii. **Registration Certificate of Ready Mix Concrete Batching Plant:** The Registration Certificate of the ready mix concrete batching plants shall be issued through online mode by the Department. The standardized format of the registration certificate is annexed at Annexure 'B'.
- iii. **Stock Register to be maintained by a Ready Mix Concrete Batching Plant:** Stock Register shall be maintained through online mode by a ready mix concrete batching plant. The standardized format of Stock Register is annexed at Annexure 'C'.
- iv. **Monthly Returns to be submitted by a Ready Mix Concrete Batching Plant:** The RMC batching plant shall be accountable for sources of minerals and shall satisfy the concerned Mining Officers while producing the details of source in monthly return. The monthly return shall be submitted through online web portal of the department. The standardized format of monthly return is at Annexure 'D'.

The monthly return shall be filed by RMC batching plants by every 10th of next month through online web portal with the District Mining Officer concerned. If no return is submitted or any discrepancy is found in the return, a show cause notice will be issued and action will be taken as per provisions of the Punjab Crusher Policy 2022, PMMR 2013 and MMDR ACT 1957.
