1.0 Whereas various civil writ petitions have been filed in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court regarding the cases of the illegal mining and the allegations of collection of so called Gunda Tax from the vehicles carrying extraction material by mining contractors. There are also the allegations that in such illegal mining cases, vehicles do not report at the appropriate check post set up by the Department. At the same time they do not pay the royalty and the penalty as per the notification issued by the Department from time to time.

2.0 With the purpose to implement the orders of the Punjab and Haryana High Court in true letter and spirit and also to ensure that no illegal mining takes place in the State of Punjab, following additional measures are taken;

(i) Check post shall be established at following places where there are cases of illegal mining:

- (a) Khanni at Jajon Mahilpur Road, District Hoshiarpur at Himachal Pradesh border
- (b) Kharkan at Hoshiarpur Una Road, District Hoshiarpur at Himachal Pradesh border.
- (c) Kot at Garshankar Nangal Road, District Hoshiarpur at Himachal Pradesh border.
- (d) Hajipur T point at Hajipur Dasuya Road, District Hoshiarpur at Himachal Pradesh border.
- (e) Dhamian at Mansar Road, District Hoshiarpur at Himachal Pradesh border.
- (f) Village Kauntarpur, District Hoshiarpur at Himachal Pradesh border.
- (g) Village Hariyal District Pathankot at Himachal Pradesh border.
- (h) Dhaki at Pathankot Jalandhar Highway Pathankot at Himachal Pradesh border.
- (i) Village MuthiBamial District Pathankot at J&K border
- (j) Village KiriKhurd District Pahtnkot at J&K border
- (k) Handesra Naraingarh Road Check Post, District Mohali
- (l) Mubarakpur Rampur road at Daffarpur, District Mohali
- (m) Siswan Kurali T point, District Mohali
- (n) Algran, Kalwan Nangal Road, District Ropar
- (o) Khera Kalmot, Bhalri Road Nangal, District Ropar
- (p) Jindwari, Sri Anandpur Sahib Nangal Road, District Ropar

(q) Bharatgarh, Bharatgarh Panjera Road, District Ropar

(r) Kakrala, Bharatgarh, Village kakrala Bharatgarh Nalagarh, District Ropar

(s) Bikkon, Ghannuli-Bikkon-Nalagarh road, District Ropar.

(ii) The officers posted at the check post will verify the document being carried by the vehicles and in case it is found that it is illegally extracted material, the requisite royalty along with the penalty shall be charged from the vehicle at the rate of Rs. 7.00 per cubic feet.

(iii) In case such a vehicle produces any document issued by any competent authority outside the State of Punjab, the officers at the check post shall collect a copy of such document and also collect the royalty along with the penalty as mentioned in para 2.0 (ii) above. These documents will be verified by the Office of Director Mines & Geology, Punjab from the respective State Government within a period of two months. Once these documents are verified and found to be true, the royalty and the penalty paid by the vehicle shall be reimbursable on a demand made by such an applicant.


(iv) Confirmation receipt "Mineral Transport Permit" as specified in Rule 72(A)(4) will be issued immediately to all vehicle owners/drivers confirming the Mining cess deposited, whether weighment slip submitted or not and details of bank account holder's name and account number if weighment slip is submitted.


