Sr. No.	Authorised tasks
1.	To check the valid documents.
2.	Seize and impound the vehicle/carriers being used for transporting any mineral in whatever form he uses for this purpose, without valid weighment slip/valid documents and lawful authority as required under sub rule (2) of rule 74 of Punjab Minor Minerals Rules 2013.
3.	Issue Notice/receipt (Annexure-I) to the owner or person in-charge or person in possession of the said vehicle/carriers in this regard, if required.
4.	Issue Assessment order in respect of compounding fees to be imposed after due consideration of reply of Notice/Receipt.


