In exercise of the powers conferred by Rule 90 of Punjab Minor Mineral Rules 2013, the projects executed by NHAI, Railways, PWD, Water Resources Department, Mandi Board and other Government/Semi-Government Agencies and Corporations are hereby exempted from requirement of Mining Plan for the ordinary earth/clay to be excavated upto depth of 2 meters from NSL under Rule 47 of Punjab Minor Mineral Rules 2013 and be issued K-1 permits subjected to the submission of Layout plan in Annexure-1, additional conditions mentioned in Annexure-2 and following condition regarding payment of Royalty etc :-

a) Government Agency will check at the time of payment of final bills that contractor/executing agency has taken permit for all the ordinary earth/clay and paid all the royalty as per Punjab State Sand and Gravel Mining Policy 2022. If not, the government agency will deposit the royalty amount due to the State Government after deducting the same from the bills of contractor.

Additional Conditions while issuing K1 Permit for Government Projects

- I. The conditions of MoEF GOI No. L-11011/47/2011-IA.II(M) Dated 24.06.2013 shall be applicable to the permit holder.
- II. That in case District Mining Officer or any other authorized officer/official, after field inspection notices that information provided in the Layout details need certain corrections/amendments due to change in conditions either natural or manmade, the authorised officer can recommend necessary amendments in the Layout details at any point of time in the interest of environment and mineral conservation.
- III. That if the mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the approved Layout Details then District Mining Officer, any other authorized officer/official may order suspension of all or any of the mining operations and permit continuation of only such operations as may be necessary to restore the conditions in the permitted area as envisaged under the said Layout details.
- IV. Quarry planning, slope height not exceeding 45 degree from the horizontal width and width of bench should not less than the bench height.
- V. The side shall be kept benched and the height of any bench shall not exceed 1.5 meters and the breadth thereof shall not be less than the height.
- VI. No working shall be made within a distance of 7.5 meter of the permitted area boundary as required under PMMR 2013.
- VII. Streams will not be diverted to from inactive channel.
- VIII. No mining operation shall be carried out of any point within 75m of railway line or 50m from H.T. line, any public works, reservoirs tank, canal, public roads and buildings or inhabited or 10m of outer edge of any village road.
- IX. No mining operation shall be carried out 100m in side and 500m outside of the flood protecting bandh of the major river.
- X. As per Hon'ble High Court orders dated 11.09.2020 in CWP 14141 of 2020 no mining shall be carried out within 1 km from major bridges and 500 m from small bridges upstream and downstream. Similarly, no mining shall be carried out within 1 km from National Highway and 500 m from State Highway.
- XI. All provisions in safety rule & regulation will be maintained by providing required materials to the employees and there will be no violation of safety provisions.
- XII. At any stage, if it is observed that the information furnished in the Layout details are incorrect or misrepresent facts, the approval of the document shall be revoked with immediate effect.
- XIII. The concession holder in addition to Royalty, in accordance to provisions contained in the Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013 shall

deposit requisite sum towards Environment Performance Guarantee, Environment Management Fund and District Mineral Foundation Fund.

- XIV. If any comments are received from the State Government, then the necessary action as per comments shall be taken immediately.
- XV. Project Proponent will be responsible for all types of legal and administrative proceeding; no other person will be liable for this.
- XVI. Mineral ordinary earth only will be extracted from the proposed site, Mining of any other mineral will be prohibited, if done, then Mining Department would take disciplinary action against the project proponent.
- XVII. All the measures described in layout details will be implemented.
- XVIII. Permit holder will construct & maintain the approach road from the Mining Site to main road. Water sprinkling will be done on haul roads for suppression of dust, which will be generated by vehicular movement about two times a day by the sprinklers. Overloading of vehicles shall be prevented. The trucks and trolley after loading will be covered by suitable cover.
- XIX. Permit holder shall be responsible for any claim arising from the co-shareholders or the mortgaging bank etc.
