**NOTIFICATION**

**No. G.S.R. 155/C.A.67/1957/Ss.15 and 23C/Amd.(8)/2021.-** In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 read with clause (c) of sub-section 2 of section 23C of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013, namely:-

**RULES**

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Minor Mineral (Amendment) Rules, 2021.  
(2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Punjab Minor Minerals Rules, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 34, for sub-rule (6), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“(6) The contractor shall pay compensation at the rate of Rs. 50/- per tonne of the mineral excavated, to the land owner (i.e. an individual or a Panchayat or the State Government or the Central Government, as the case may be), for the damage caused to the land under contract.”
3. In the said rules, in the SCHEDULE, for serial Nos. 4, 9 and 10, and the entries relating thereto, the following shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“ 4. Gravel (Bajri)	Rupees 18.25 per tonne”
“ 9. (a) Ordinary clay	Rupees 0.0 per tonne
(b) Ordinary earth	Rupees 0.0 per tonne
10. Ordinary sand used for non-industrial purpose	Rupees 18.25 per tonne”
