NOTIFICATION

The 5th December, 2022

No.02/06/91-IT2(P.F.)/1424 :- In exercise of the powers conferred under section 213(1) and 114 of the Central Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and all others powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to delegate the power to inspect and challan the overloaded vehicles carrying minor mineral [as defined under Mines and Mineral (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957] to the Executive Engineers & Sub Divisional Officers of the Mining and Vigilance Administration of the Water Resources, Mines & Geology Department, Punjab. *The officers so empowered will not have the power to compound the offence.*

2. The officers of Water Resources, Mines & Geology Department, Punjab *will not have the power to inspect any vehicle other than vehicles carrying minor mineral [as defined under Mines and Mineral (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957].*

3. This notification shall be implemented with immediate effect.


